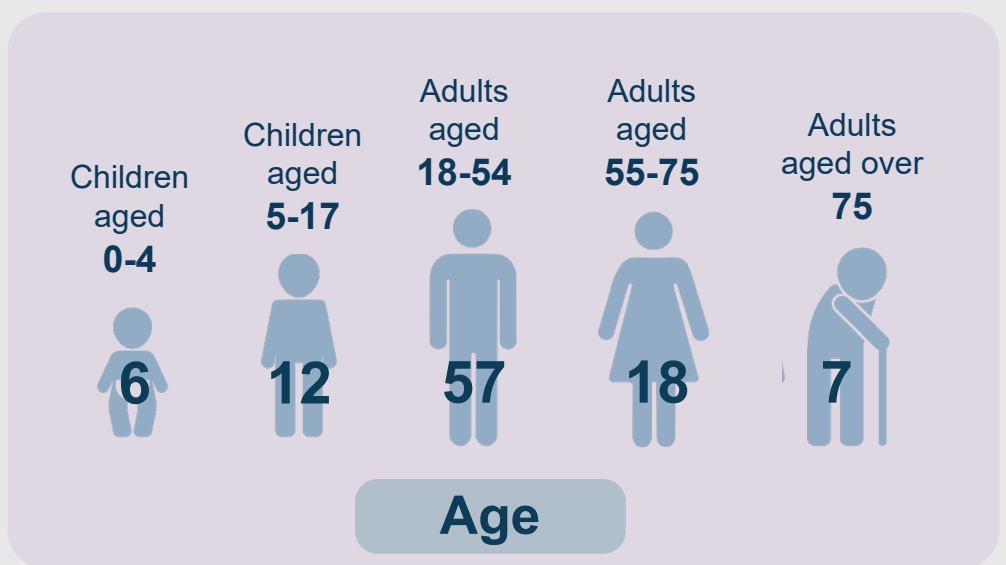
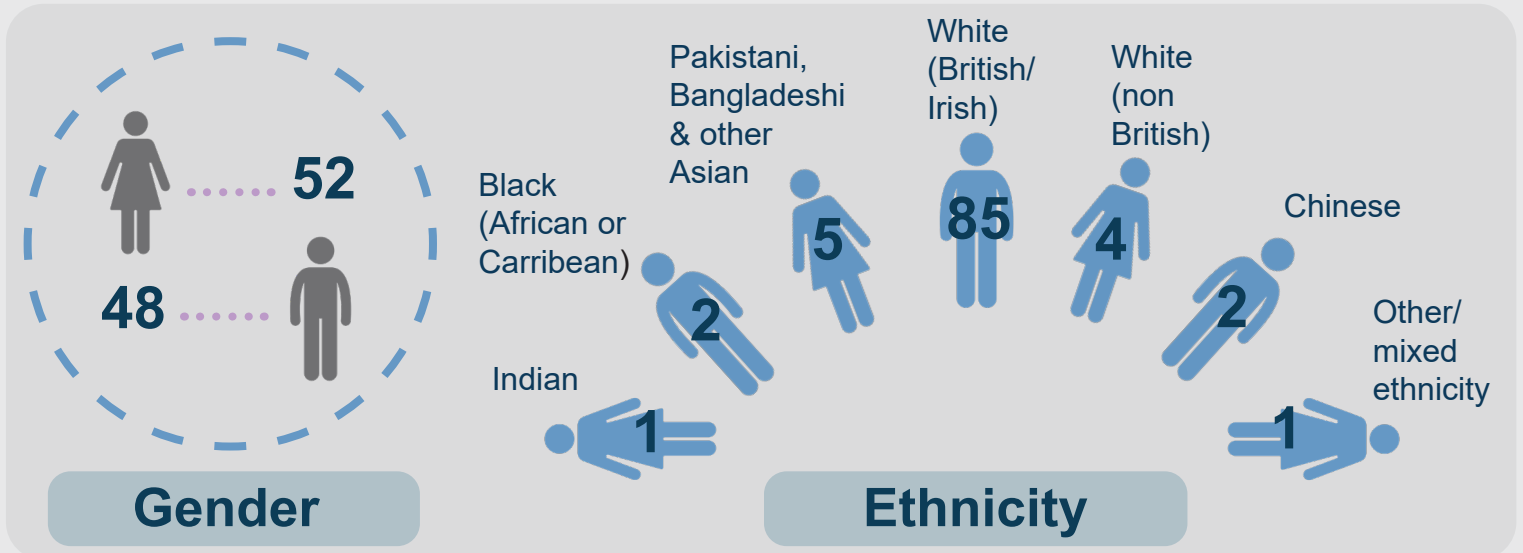

What if Glasgow was a village of 100 people? What would the population look like?

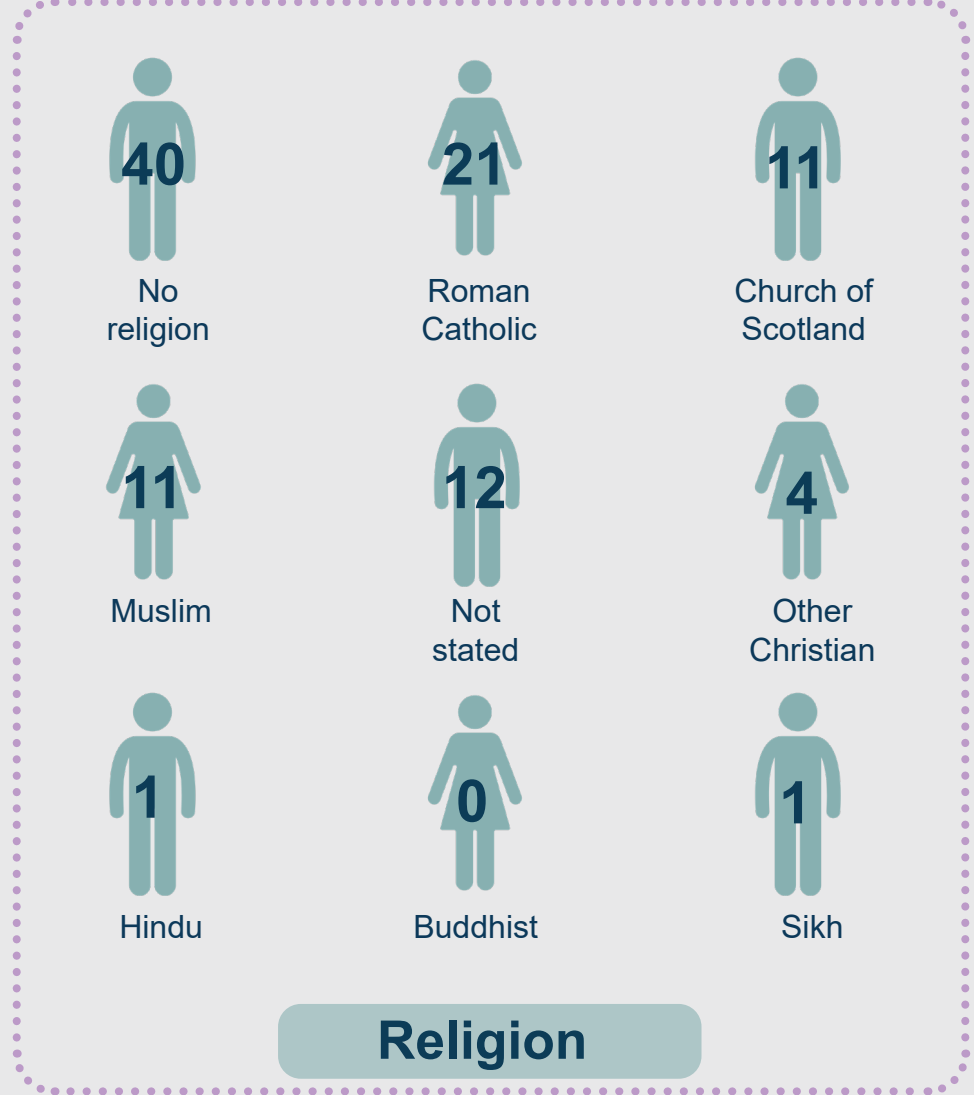
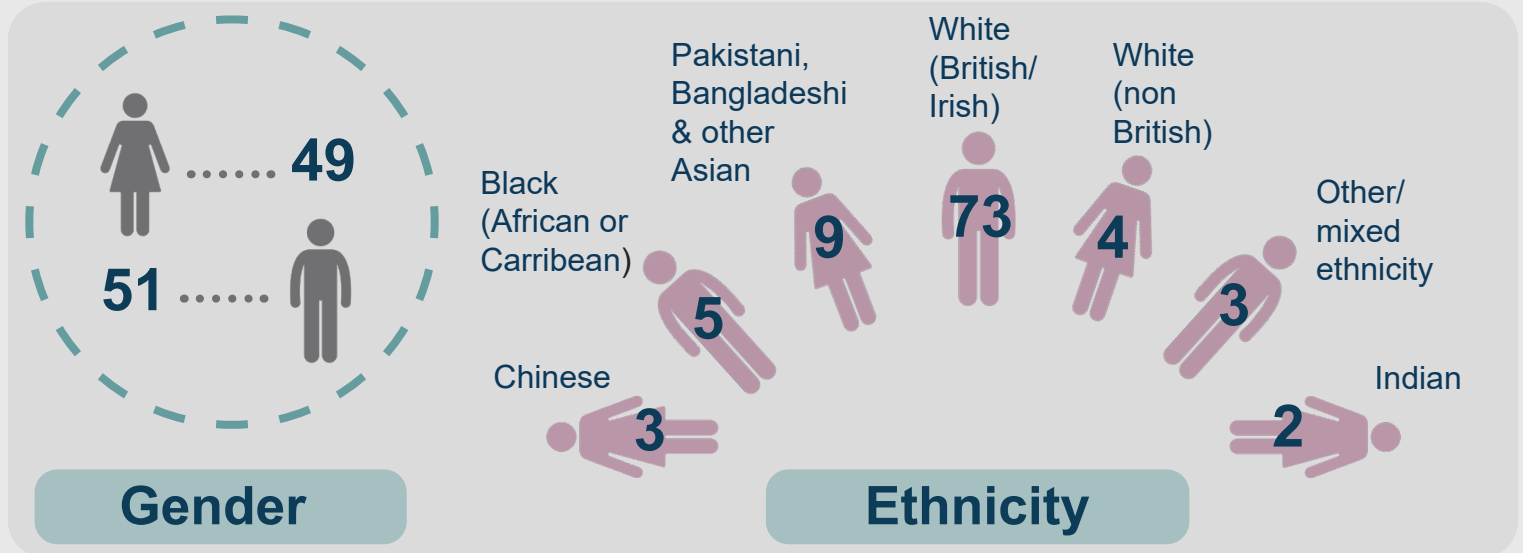
There are almost **600,000 people** living in Glasgow.

There are **35,053 pre-school children** (aged 0-4) living in Glasgow. Represented in 100 people, the pre-school population looks like this:

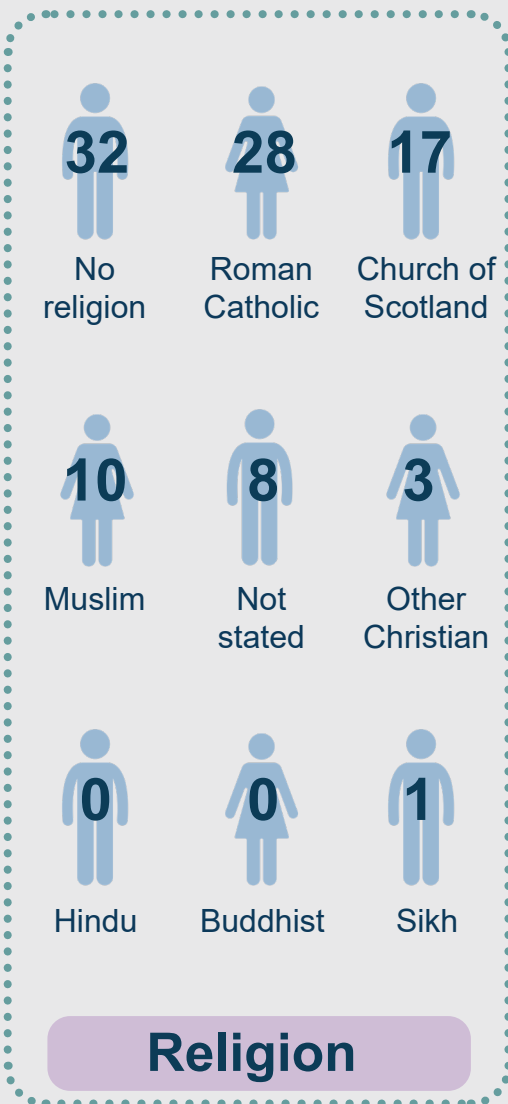
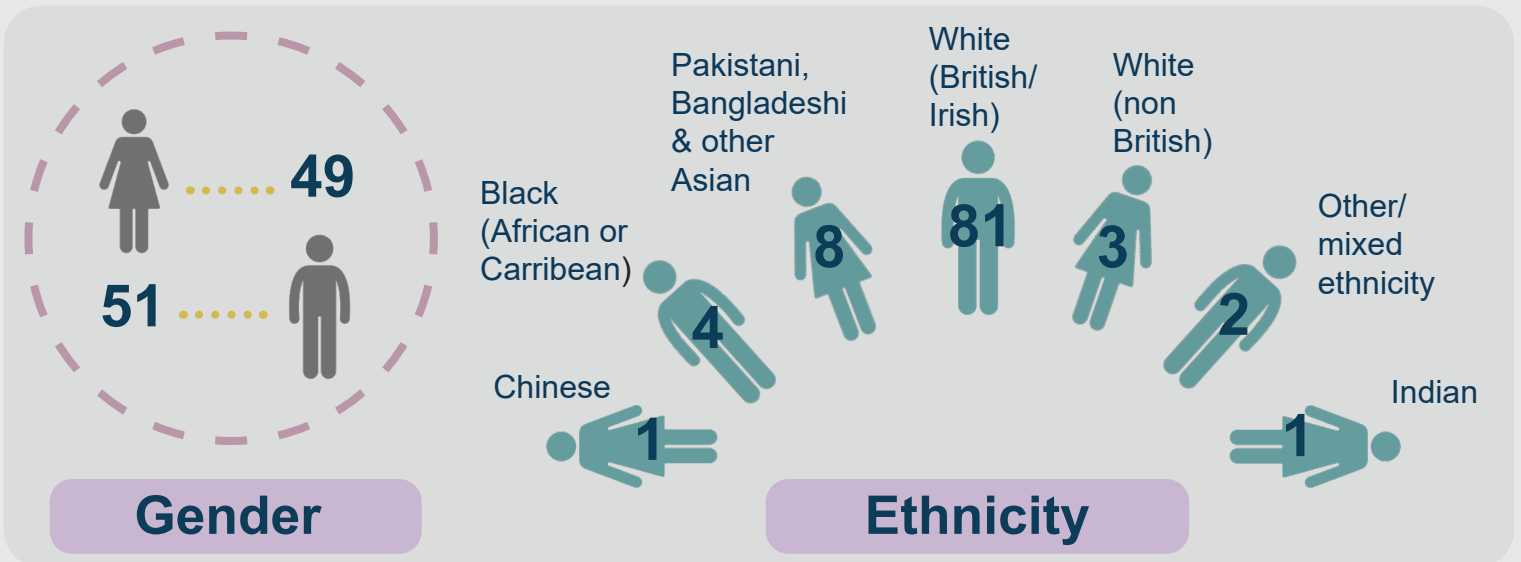

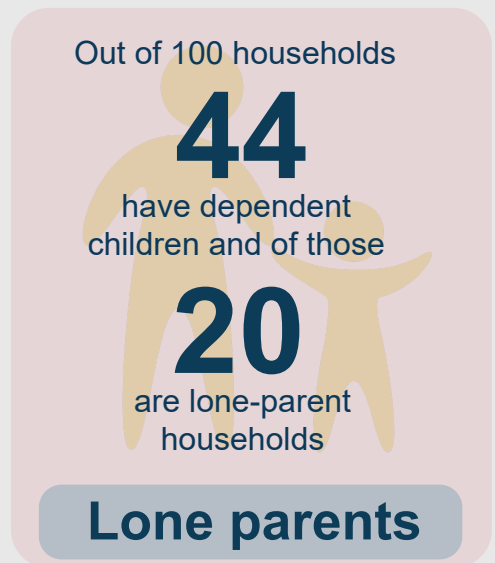
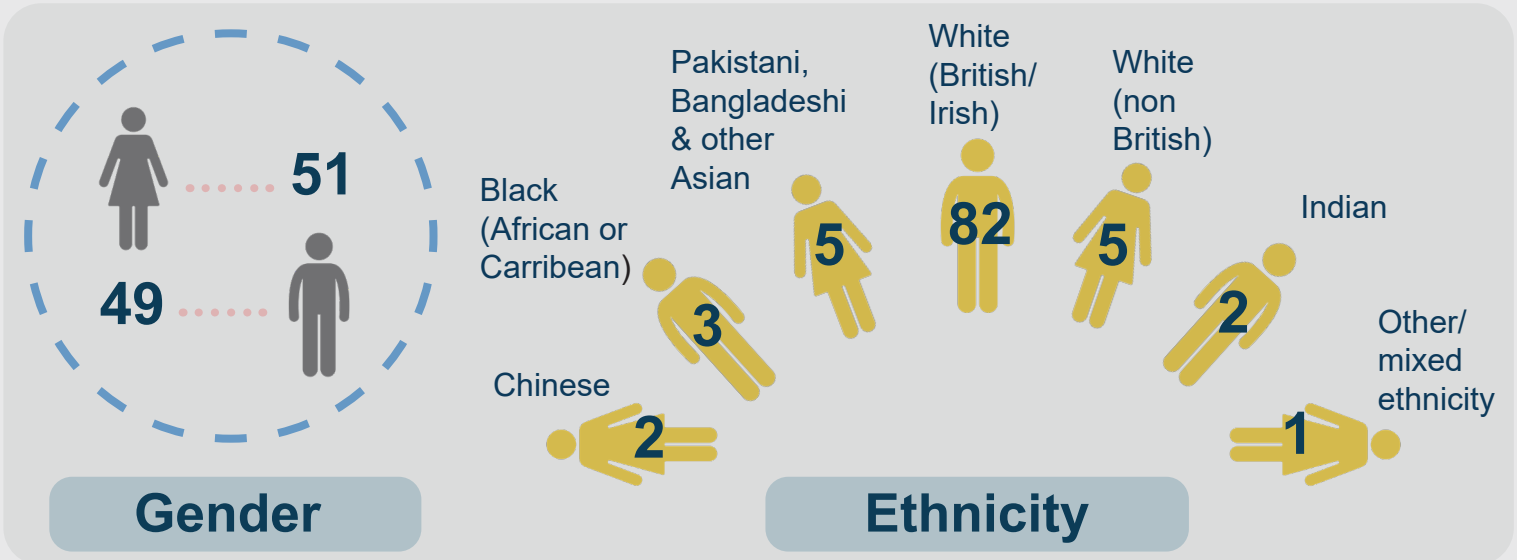
There are 74,193 **school-aged children** (aged 5-17) living in Glasgow. Represented in 100 people, the school-age population of the city looks like this:

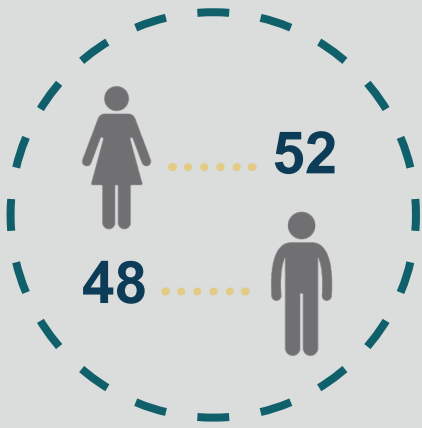
There are 344,040 adults aged between 18 and 54 living in Glasgow. Represented in 100 people, the school-age population of the city looks like this:



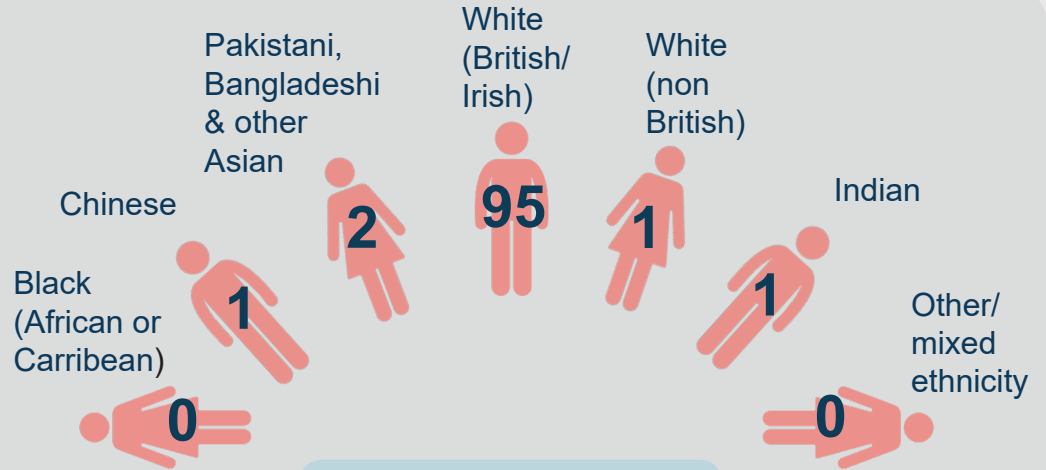

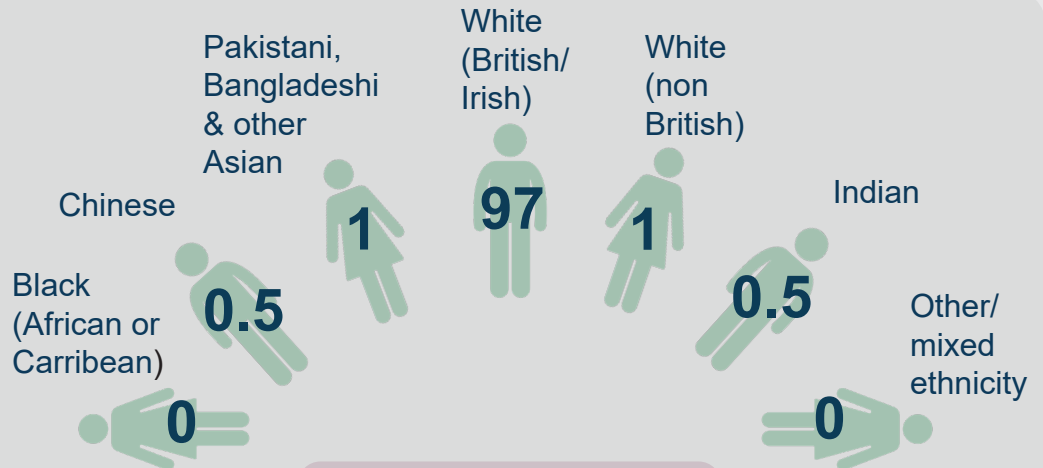
