

Birth rates

Birth rates have risen slightly over the last decade.

In 2023, there were

5,977

babies born in the city.



Infant death rates

Infant death rates, which were so high in the 1850s, have reduced steadily over the last 170 years. In 2023, the infant death rate stood at:



3.7 per **1,000** live births.

Looking to the future



The child population in Glasgow is predicted to decrease by

7% between 2018 and 2043.

Ethnicity



In 2022, **33%** of Glasgow's children (aged 0-15) were from a non-white ethnic group.

A further **7%** were from a white ethnic group other than 'White Scottish'.

Language



In 2022, **11%** of 3-15 year olds in Glasgow spoke more than one language, with a main language other than English being spoken at home.
