Immunisations

In 2023, Scotland had achieved a **96%** coverage of the 6-in-1 vaccine among children at age 12 months.

92% of children in Glasgow City Region aged 24 months had received the first MMR dose.



There are inequalities in the uptake of the HPV vaccine. In 2022:



- uptake was **higher among girls** compared to boys
- uptake was **higher in SIMD5** compared to SIMD1

mental health



In 2021 in Glasgow City Region, pupils across P5-S6 reported:

- **26%** excellent mental health
- **48%** good mental health
- **19%** fair mental health
- **3%** poor mental health

Physical activity

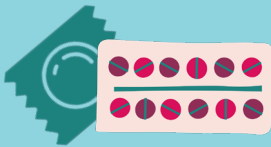
In 2022 in Glasgow City Region:

- **48%** pupils walked to school
- **3%** pupils cycled to school
- **3%** scooted/skated to school

3% of P5-S6 reported they **never did any physical activity.**



Sexual activity and pregnancy



In 2022, **14%** of S4-S6 pupils reported being sexually active.

58% had used contraception to prevent pregnancy the last time they had sex.



In Glasgow City Region there has been a **continous downward trend** in the rate of pregnancies among young people since 2009-11.

In Glasgow in 2020, teen pregnancies were **more likely to result in terminations** than in 2011.



Dental hygiene

In 2022, **69%** of P1 pupils had no obvious decay experience.

There were however considerable differences depending on SIMDs:

- **86%** of P1s in SIMD5
- **57%** of P1s in SIMD1



Breastfeeding



In 2022/23, **67%** of babies were breastfed at first visit.

This percentage more than halved at the 6-to-8 week review: **29%**, and again at the 13-15 months review: **14%**.
